Important Items to Take With You

You will have 7 days after eviction to pick up your belongings, excluding Sundays and federal holidays. You and your landlord must agree on times to pick up your items. You will have at least two days to pick up your items for no less than 16 hours total, between 8 am and 6 pm, during those 7 days. The landlord must provide contact information for who to contact to arrange for that access on the date of the hearing.
